INTERIM INTERNATIONAL ARRIVALS BUILDING (NOW OPERATIONAL)

 To accommodate immediate needs for additional international capacity, the current IAB has been expanded and upgraded to serve as an interim facility until the permanent International Arrivals Facility (IAF) opens in 2023

PARKING & TRANSPORTATION CENTER (NOW OPERATIONAL)

- Six-story terminal garage
- Dedicated Ground Transportation Center

TERMINAL APRON & TAXILANE EXPANSION (COMPLETION IN 2023)

- Project underway now to fill a 50-foot depression near the terminal to add space to accommodate construction of the new IAF
- After the IAF opens in 2023, the space will be used for aircraft parking and maneuvering

DYNAMIC GROWTH AND EXPANSION PLAN FOR NASHVILLE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

By 2037, the population of the Greater Nashville Area is expected to surpass 2.5 million people, and BNA passenger traffic will grow from 15 million today to more than 23 million. *BNA Vision* is a comprehensive plan designed to enable the airport to meet the needs of this record-setting growth and maintain the customer-friendly character unique to our region.

CONCOURSE D & TERMINAL WINGS EXPANSION (COMING 2020)

- 6 additional gates to increase capacity to attract new airlines and services
- New retail and dining offerings
- Additional ticketing stations and baggage claim carousels

TERMINAL GARAGE & AIRPORT ADMINISTRATIVE BUILDING (COMING 2020)

- 3,000-space garage
- 64,000-square-foot office building
- Pedestrian plaza

INTERNATIONAL ARRIVALS FACILITY (COMING 2023)

 State-of-the-art facility to accommodate the increase of international travelers and set the stage for attracting new nonstop flights to Europe, Asia, Latin America and more

POTENTIAL HOTEL (IN PROGRAMMING & DESIGN)

- On-site hotel
- 1,800-space garage

CENTRAL TERMINAL (COMING 2023)

- Spacious central entrance hall will warmly welcome travelers with natural light and compelling airfield views
- Comfortably accommodate airline ticketing, baggage check-in, and federal security screening
- Queuing for security screening will be consolidated, and additional lanes will minimize wait times and expedite the process

DONELSON PIKE RELOCATION & TERMINAL ACCESS ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS (COMING 2023)

- TDOT will relocate a portion of Donelson Pike slightly to the east to improve traffic circulation and terminal access
- BNA will expand and improve the airport's terminal loop roadway
