

Dynamic Growth & Expansion Plan For Nashville International Airport (BNA)





A World-Class Airport for a World-Class City

By 2041, the population of the Greater Nashville Area is expected to surpass 2.5 million people. By 2032, BNA passenger traffic will grow from 16 million today to more than 23 million. *BNA Vision* is a comprehensive plan designed to enable the airport to meet the needs of this record-setting growth and maintain the customer-friendly character unique to our region.



Interim International Arrivals Building (Now Operational)

- To accommodate immediate needs for additional international capacity, the current IAB has been expanded and upgraded to serve as an interim facility until the permanent International Arrivals Facility (IAF) opens in 2023

Terminal Garage (Now Operational)

- Six-story terminal garage
- Dedicated Ground Transportation Center

Terminal Apron & Taxilane Expansion (Complete in 2023)

- Phase 1 entails filling a 50-foot depression near the terminal to add space to accommodate construction of the new IAF
- When the IAF opens in 2023, the space will be used for aircraft parking and maneuvering

Concourse D & Terminal Wings Expansion (Opening Summer 2020)

- 6 additional gates to increase capacity to attract new airlines and services
- New retail and dining offerings
- Additional ticketing stations and baggage claim carousels

Terminal Garage, Pedestrian Plaza & Airport Administrative Building (Opening 2020/2021)

- 3,000-space garage
- Dedicated Valet Parking area
- 64,000-square-foot office building
- Pedestrian plaza

International Arrivals Facility (Opening 2023)

- State-of-the-art facility to accommodate the increase of international travelers and set the stage for attracting new nonstop flights to Europe, Asia, Latin America and more

Terminal Garage & On-Site Hotel (Opening 2023)

- On-site hotel
- 1,800-space Terminal Garage

Terminal Lobby Renovation (Completion in 2023)

- Spacious central entrance hall will warmly welcome travelers with natural light and compelling airfield views
- Comfortably accommodate airline ticketing, and baggage check-in
- Expedite the security screening process with an expanded and consolidated security checkpoint

Donelson Pike Relocation & Terminal Access Roadway Improvements (Completion in 2023)

- TDOT will relocate a portion of Donelson Pike slightly to the east to improve traffic circulation and terminal access
- BNA will expand and improve the airport's terminal loop roadway
