BNA's Interim International Arrivals Building (IAB) is newly expanded and upgraded to better accommodate international travelers. It will serve as our international passenger processing center until a permanent, state-of-the-art International Arrivals Facility opens in 2023.

AT A GLANCE

- Now operational.
- Expands passenger boarding bridges from 1 to 2 to accommodate 2 arriving flights simultaneously.
- Increases processing capacity from 200 passengers per hour to 400.
- Connects directly to the baggage claim, eliminating the need to re-check baggage.
- Improved U.S. Customs and Border Protection processing area.
- International destinations served:
 - London (Heathrow) – May 2018
 - Calgary
 - Cancun
 - Cozumel
 - Grand Bahama Island
 - Montego Bay
 - Punta Cana
 - Toronto
