Interim International Arrivals Building (IAB) Expansion & Upgrade (Completed)

- To accommodate immediate needs for additional international capacity, the current IAB has been expanded and upgraded to serve as an interim facility until the permanent International Arrivals Facility (IAF) opens in 2023

Terminal Garage 1 (Complete in Early 2021)

- Six story, 2,800-space garage
- Dedicated Valet parking area
- 64,000-square-foot office building
- Pedestrian plaza

Terminal Garage 2 (Completed)

- Six-story, 2,200-space garage
- Dedicated Ground Transportation Center

Terminal Garage & On-Site Hotel (In Design, Complete in 2023)

- On-site, Hilton-Branded hotel
- 1,800-space Terminal Garage

Concourse D & Terminal Wings Expansion (Completed)

- 6 additional gates to increase capacity to attract new airlines and services
- Additional ticketing stations and baggage claim carousels

International Arrivals Facility (Under Construction, Complete in 2023)

- State-of-the-art facility to accommodate the increase of international travelers
- Will and set the stage for attracting new nonstop flights to Europe, Asia, Latin America and more

Terminal Lobby Renovation (Under Construction, Complete in 2023)

- Spacious central entrance hall will warmly welcome travelers with natural light and compelling airfield views

Terminal Lobby Renovation (Continued)

- Will comfortably accommodate airline ticketing, and baggage check-in
- Will expedite the security screening process

Terminal Apron & Taxiway Expansion (Complete in 2023)

- Phase 1 entailed filling a 50-foot depression near the terminal to add space to accommodate construction of the new IAF
- When the IAF opens in 2023, the space will be used for aircraft parking and maneuvering

Terminal Access Roadway Improvements (In Design, Complete in 2024)

- TDOT will relocate a portion of Donelson Pike slightly to the east to improve traffic circulation and terminal access
- BNA will expand and improve the airport's terminal loop roadway in tandem with the Donelson Pike relocation
